## INTRODUCTION

### Historical Note

By 1920, more than 150,000 Russians lived in Harbin, with nearly as many again in Shanghai. In Harbin, Russian émigrés felt as if they were still in Russia - the Chinese Eastern Railway was administered by a Russo-Chinese administration and offered employment to émigrés. There were schools, churches, clubs, stores, theaters, concert halls, newspapers, journals and a Russian City Council. By the late 1920s, it became more complicated to cross the Russian border and Russian immigration to China came to a halt. However, the cultural life of Harbin and Shanghai continued to flourish. There were Russian theaters, clubs, musical societies and many cultural establishments for children. N. S. Slavianskii was a theater director during that period and set up many cultural events in both cities. In the late 1940s, he and his wife left China and settled in San-Francisco.

### History of the Papers and Their Organization

In 2003, the N. S. Slavianskii Collection was purchased from a dealer in New York.

## DESCRIPTION OF THE COLLECTION

### Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of programs of plays staged by N. S. Slavianskii, of his wife's musical engagements, and of performances related to the Russian community in Harbin, Shanghai and San-Francisco. It also contains Slavianskii's correspondence, directorial notes, newspaper clippings, typescripts of press releases, reviews, and posters of musical and theatrical events. The collection will be of particular interest to scholars studying the history of the cultural life of Russian Diaspora of the twentieth century.
